

“The RVAMAC shall strive for consensus in all decisions. The first vote on a matter will be by consensus. To decide a matter by consensus any voting member, after recognition by the presiding officer, may ask for objections. If there are none the matter is decided in the affirmative. If there is an objection discussion continues until the objection is resolved. If the objection cannot be resolved the matter will either be tabled until the next regular meeting (or until a special meeting if the matter is urgent) or the matter may be withdrawn by the originating member. If the matter is not withdrawn and consensus still cannot be reached then a vote will be taken and both the majority and minority views will be documented and presented to the public and any relevant agencies.”
