Examples of eligible projects include but are not limited to: medical or dental clinics, healthcare facilities, police or fire departments, and public works vehicles. Community Facilities grants cannot be used to pay initial operating expenses or annual recurring expenses, refinance existing debt, pay interest, build or repair facilities in non-rural areas, or pay for construction costs of facilities that will be used for commercial rental space.

11. Discussion and possible action: Whether to request, again, that the county seek money for Round Valley area road work from the CTC or federal infrastructure funding. Approve second letter to Board of Supervisors and County Department of Transportation.
