re: HM4 project requests for the Round Valley Area

Dear Mr. Krause:

At our January MAC meeting, it was suggested that we provide you with a list of work we would request be included in a project under HM4 for our area. The following initial list is compiled from community requests and input during our February 7, 2024, meeting:

- Crosswalks over 162 at the intersections of Eberle, Greeley and Grange Streets
- Improved drainage along Howard Street
- Sidewalks along Howard Street and crosswalk at Post Office
- Sidewalks and improved drainage along 162 between Eberle and East Lane
- 2 speed humps on Howard Street and 2 speed humps on Foothill Blvd.
- Add signage for streets that cross 162 downtown
- rectangular rapid flashing beacons at crosswalks
- increased pedestrian safety along Main Street between Grange and Howard
- redesign of intersection of Howard and Airport Blvd. for high school and elementary/middle school student safety
- a complete Safe Streets plan for Covelo
