Hi Kay, thanks for keeping me in the loop. I'll let Andreas speak to the HM4 project requests on the State System, but I believe the HM4 program is only applicable to the State Highway system.

Some of the improvements requested that are off the State Highway could be good candidates for some of the current and upcoming grant programs. These would need to be applied for by the County or MCOAG or in conjunction with partners. I think the last bullet, 'complete Safe Streets plan for Covelo', would be a good place to start. I know there has been a couple of previous planning documents in 2010 and 2014 that were completed but it might be a good time to refresh or undertake a new plan. This would allow you to pursue construction funding with a higher likelihood of success.

There is a program called Safe Streets For All (SS4A) that funds both planning and construction activities to prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries (program link below). To be eligible for the construction funds through this program, you would have to have completed a planning grant previously. Applications for this program are due April 4th.

There are other programs as well through different sources and different times of the year. Let me know if you need any further information or if you would like to touch base on anything else.
