MEETING NOTES:

Liam Porter and Russ Ford from the County Planning Department presented on a proposed inland ordinance amendment to allow low intensity camping. Several Tribal members, including two council members, came to voice their concern regarding a letter submitted by a local citizen regarding enforcement of cannabis ordinances. A discussion ensued. As the MAC does not have a quorum, no action was taken.

The MAC has two seats available for Tribal members, appointed by the Council.

The question was raised whether a Tribal member must be a registered voter to be able to serve on the MAC. Supervisor Haschak is investigating.
