## Meeting Notes

1. Call to Order & Roll call: Meeting called to order at 6:01 PM. Present: Dane Downing, Marylou Mileck, Kathy Britton. Absent: Laura Betts, Charles Sargenti, James Russ, Michelle Downey.

4. Public comments and announcements.

We have five seats open on the council. Two are designated for Tribal members, three open to anyone. Any interested person should contact Supervisor Haschak for information on the application process.

Candace Reynolds, Certified Ecological Restoration Practitioner (CERP) and grants coordinator for HANA Resources did a Power Point presentation: "Covelo Community Park and Recreational Center: A Round Valley Transformative Climate Community". 5. Reports

c. Supervisor Haschak: County and State budgets were passed. John is trying to get the Haz Mobile to Round Valley with little success. Concerned citizens can contact Mendo Recycle. No update on the Skate Park. Annexation of the Ukiah area is a big topic at the BOS. The Low Intensity Camping Ordinance AB518 is moving through the process. Currently at State Assembly.

b. Sheriff Kendall reported that Round Valley has been very busy last month with 270 calls. One arrest was made in connection with the Hulls Valley homicide. MCSO worked with Fish and Wildlife last week in RV and completed more raids. Two academy graduates are now in training, and MCSO has one new person from Lake Co. There has been no update on the noise ordinance. Several persons reported that 2-5 AM is a noisy time in RV.

f. Monica Barragan of Assemblyman Chris Rogers' office reported that they had received the letter from the MCSO, BOS and Fish & Wildlife regarding the unregulated cannabis cultivation in RV and will report on this next month. AB263 is on its way to State Senate.

g. CVFD: Fire Chief Ruben Rojas reported that the District has four new volunteers. The new ambulance is in service. There have been weekly trainings for wildland firefighting. They are looking for grants for a "Type 6" engine and various equipment. EMS equipment is being updated with the help of a PG&E reimbursement. EMT training begins 8/7 for approximately 3 months. In 2024 they responded to 436 calls.

h. Lourance Hall: The Town Creek Bio-Engineering Restoration Project begins in August.
