Has Caltrans provided any information on when they plan to complete the lane-striping work on Highway 162?

With the rainy season approaching, visibility on wet roads—especially at night—will become increasingly challenging without clearly painted lane lines. Last year, temporary orange plastic delineators were left in place to mark the roadway edge, and although the dry season offered ample time for permanent striping, the work still has not been completed.

Several sections of Highway 162 have pavement that extends directly to steep drop-offs, and over the past year many of the delineators have been damaged or lost, further reducing safety. Given the history of serious accidents on this highway, the community is understandably concerned.

Can we get an update on Caltrans' schedule for finishing the striping and restoring proper lane markings on Highway 162?
