Additional Projects within Round Valley

Mendocino County HSIP Project. The County was recently awarded a total of \$2,578,140 for a Highway Safety Improvement Program grant that includes the construction of a sidewalk/pathway along Crawford from Biggar Lane to Foothill Boulevard. MCOG provided LTF 2% funding for the grant match.

Covelo/Round Valley Safe Route to School Project (recommended for funding). At the end of last week, we learned that the County's application for a Safe Routes to Schools project in Covelo has been recommended for funding by California Transportation Commission staff as part of the Active Transportation Program. Final approval of the project list is planned for the December CTC meeting. The Covelo/ Round Valley Safe Routes to School Project is an infrastructure project that focuses on pedestrian and bicyclists' safety improvements. The goal of this project is to improve safety for children and for other community members to walk and bike and to bring equity and economic equality to the town by improving and connecting the town's sidewalk system between schools, residences, and community buildings, and by installing important safety improvements, such as curbs, gutters, ADA ramps, crosswalks, and signage, along the roads and at intersections. The project includes the installation of sidewalks, curbs, gutters, crosswalks, bike lanes, and of other infrastructure methods to improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety along various locations along Howard Street, CR 334D, Airport Road, CR 337B, and Foothill Boulevard, CR 337A.
